BOTTOM LINE

LET GOD'S WORDS BE YOUR WORTH.

SCRIPTURE

As Pharaoh approached, the people of Israel looked up and panicked when they saw the Egyptians overtaking them. They cried out to the Lord, and they said to Moses, "Why did you bring us out here to die in the wilderness? Weren't there enough graves for us in Egypt? What have you done to us? Why did you make us leave Egypt? Didn't we tell you this would happen while we were still in Egypt? We said, 'Leave us alone! Let us be slaves to the Egyptians. It's better to be a slave in Egypt than a corpse in the wilderness!'" But Moses told the people, "Don't be afraid. Just stand still and watch the Lord rescue you today. The Egyptians you see today will never be seen again. The Lord himself will fight for you. Just stay calm" (Exodus 14:10-14 NLT).

GOAL OF SMALL GROUP

To encourage students not to measure their value or potential by the negative messages of others.

THINK ABOUT THIS

Leaders — High schoolers rarely feel important until they do something important; they want to do something that matters. They want less conversation and more action in their life. Now is a great time to encourage them to find opportunities to use their skills to serve.

SAY THIS

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What's the first thing you would buy if you believed that every message in every commercial you saw was true?
2. Whether it's sarcastic comments, passive aggressive statements, or guilt trips, how do negative messages limit us?
3. How did Moses avoid being "boxed in" or limited by other people's words?
4. What do you think it means to let God's words be your worth?
5. Think about some of the messages you've allowed to steer you: the negative messages you've repeated over and over in your mind. How are those messages different from what God says about you?
6. What would you do differently if you believed God's messages about you over the negative messages of others?
7. How could elevating God's messages about you change your future?

TRY THIS

Leaders — Text one of the verses below to your students this week to remind them what God says about them.

- *Your workmanship is marvelous—how well I know it (Psalm 139:14 NLT).*
- *Of all the people on earth, the Lord your God has chosen you to be his own special treasure (Deuteronomy 7:6b NLT).*
- *Nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord (Romans 8:39b NLT).*
- *For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do (Ephesians 2:10 NIV).*
- *See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! (1 John 3:1a NIV).*
