SUMMARY OF MESSAGE

Tonight we are starting a new series called "Ask." The goal of this series is to show students that it is okay to come to InsideOut with your questions and beyond that it is okay to come to God with those questions. We are starting by looking at something that is often taboo to talk about in church, doubt. Part of the reason that we don't bring God our questions is that we are afraid of showing any sign of doubt. The reality is God can handle our doubt. In fact when we speak up about the doubts we have or ask the questions that are rolling around in our head we often times see that they become a catalyst for our faith. Our challenge for students tonight is that they would share the questions they have as well as their doubts so together we could grow in our faith.

- 1) Why do you think it makes people uncomfortable to ask questions or talk about doubt in church?
- 2) How does keeping quiet about our doubt end up hurting our faith?
- 3) When the dad asked Jesus to help his unbelief, Jesus did. In what area do you need Jesus to help your unbelief?
- 4) Does the thought of being honest about your doubts or questions make you uncomfortable?
- 5) Name one proactive thing you can do this week to deal with your doubts and questions.
