SUMMARY OF MESSAGE

Tonight we are starting a new series called "Ask." The idea of this series is to show students that it is okay to have questions and it is even okay to ask those questions. All throughout the Bible people have big questions that they ask God/Jesus. Our role as Christians and people exploring the idea of faith isn't that we need to keep our questions and doubts quiet but that we can ask the questions we have and seek answers. Tonight we are looking at a question some people ask Jesus, "who is my neighbor." We will walk through the story of the Good Samaritan and show students the idea that no matter who the person is we are called to be a neighbor to them. We are going to challenge students to choose one person they don't care for and start to show them love and kindness.
