SCRIPTURE

A relationship with God is about trusting and receiving not doing and achieving.

Mark 10:17-27

SUMMARY OF MESSAGE

Tonight we are finishing our "Ask" series with a very important question. A man asks Jesus, "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" This question poses a common problem among all people today. It shines a light on the idea that "being right with God" is all about doing something. Students often feel like they have to do things the right way or be good or get all the answers to faith correct in order for God to love or accept them. Our goal tonight is to show students that faith is about receiving not achieving God's love and grace. Our challenge for students is that they would stop trying to achieve God's love and begin receiving it. We want them to understand God's grace and live their life to trust and receive all that God has to give.
