Matthew 7:13-14

SUMMARY OF MESSAGE

Tonight we are starting a new two-week series called "Nothing Ordinary." The idea of the series is around the reality that none of us want to pursue a life that is just ordinary. We all want something more and how we choose to go after may affect our future and determine whether or not we ever escape ordinary. We are going to look at two paths that Jesus lays out when it comes to living your life. One path he calls "broad" and says that it leads to destruction. Unfortunately this is the path most students take on their quest for individuality. The other is the "Narrow" which Jesus says leads to life but few find it. We want students to understand the importance of trusting Jesus on the narrow road as well as show them that a life on the narrow road is "nothing ordinary."
